**August 20<sup>th</sup>, 2002**


**WHEREAS** the appearance and values of each Highland residence depends on the appearance of the whole neighborhood, and


**WHEREAS** the Architectural Committee has asked the Board for assistance on the "grass removal" situation, and

**WHEREAS** the Architectural Design Manual (Article 8- revision of Architectural Manual) states "The Board may from time to time amend, modify or revise..." (Changes not binding until notice given)

**THEREFORE** the Board does declare a moratorium on all grass removal, except for replacement with grass, until new recommendations are studied and recommended by a committee made up of members of the Architectural Committee, members of the Board, and residents at large, and adopted by the Board.
